Quilt Show Information

Please review the complete set of guidelines, rules, and definitions.

- Entry Form, identification photo, and entry fee must be postmarked by August 1, 2010.
- Do NOT send your quilt with the registration form.
- Entries will be limited so register your quilts early!
- Entry fee is \$15 per quilt.
- Please include a separate form and non-returnable photo for each entry. Photos may be digital or printed and may be printed on regular paper, since they will be for identification purposes only.
- Please include a SASE (Self-Addressed Stamped Envelope) with your entry form. Detailed instructions will be mailed using this SASE prior to your shipment of your quilt.
- Quilts must be shipped to arrive between September 13th and **September 17th**, 2010. If you wish to drop-off your quilt, you may make an appointment with the Show Coordinator via email at Linda@thatssewspecial.com.
- Please fill out the registration form completely, so that your quilt may be entered into the appropriate category. Categories will be determined by size and type of machine quilting. Techniques used will be the basis of a further division if the number of quilts in a category is determined to be too large to be judged fairly.
- Ribbons and awards will be for first, second, and third places in each category, Best of Show, and People's Choice.
- Insurance of up to \$500 will be provided for each quilt entered. It is highly recommended that quilts over \$500 in value be appraised and the owner have the appropriate amount of insurance to insure the quilt while in transit and at QwM 2010. For QwM to provide additional insurance, a copy of the appraisal should be sent with the registration.
- Quilts with a false back will be disqualified.
- A fabric label is suggested for your quilt, to assist in identification.

Definitions:

- Each quilt must be constructed of at least three layers; the top and back of fabric and the center layer of batting, stitched together by machine.
- Wholecloth quilts should be constructed of a single fabric top, pieced for size only.
- Computerized quilting is defined as quilting that is accomplished using software and hardware to guide the quilting machine.
- Embellishments are added elements to the quilt top's design, including but not limited to: painting, inking, or coloring of the fabric, beading, buttons, or the application of found objects, or embroidery, either by hand or by machine.
- Appliqué refers to the addition of an added layer(s) of fabric, either by hand or machine, to the quilt top to add to the design.
- Neither Appliqué nor Embellishment is required of the quilt entry.
